



SPANISH 21

MORE WAYS TO WIN! THE FUN IS BACK!

Spanish 21 is similar to Blackjack but uses eight Spanish decks A-9, J, Q, K (no 10s).

PLAYER BLACKJACK

Always BEATS dealer's Blackjack – pays 3-2.

PLAYER TOTAL OF 21

Always beats dealer's total of 21 unless the dealer has Blackjack and the player has 21 with more than two cards. Pays up to 3-1.

PAIR SPLITTING

Player may split cards of equal value including ACES creating up to 3 hands - hitting and doubling of split hands including ACES is allowed.

DOUBLE DOWN

Double with two or more cards on any total, including after splitting. No bonuses are paid on doubled hands. If the dealer has Blackjack, only the original Spanish 21 wager is collected.

DOUBLE DOWN RESCUE

After doubling if a player is dissatisfied with his non-busted hand, he may rescue (take back) the DOUBLED portion of the bet, forfeiting the original wager.

INSURANCE

When the dealer's up card is an Ace, the player may make an additional wager known as INSURANCE. INSURANCE protects the player's hand against the possibility of the dealer having a BLACKJACK. The player can wager up to 50% of the original wager. If the dealer has a BLACKJACK, the INSURANCE bet is paid 2-1 and the original bet is lost. Essentially, you break even if you wager 50% of the original bet.

LATE SURRENDER IS ALLOWED

Players may surrender one half of their wager after receiving their first two cards. However, if the dealer has Blackjack, the entire bet loses.

Player holds suited 7-7-7

voids Super Bonus

FIVE BIG PAYOFFS !

MATCH THE DEALER

DESCRIPTION:

In addition to the regular 21 bet, a player can bet that either or both of his first two cards will exactly match the dealer's up card in rank. (For example: a four matches only a four, a queen matches only a queen, etc.)

HOW TO PLAY:

The player makes a Match the Dealer wager by placing a bet in the Match the Dealer circle. In order to play Match the Dealer, the player must make a regular 21 bet.

BET LIMITS:

Minimum bet is \$1, the house sets the maximum. The maximum Match the Dealer bet is \$200. Wager is paid at odds of 1-1 with the exception of Blackjack, which is paid at odds of 3-2.

FIVE BIG PAYOFFS:

1 Non-Suited Match:	3 - 1
2 Non-Suited Match:	6 - 1
1 Suited Match:	12 - 1
1 Non-Suited & 1 Suited Match:	15 - 1
2 Suited Matches:	24 - 1



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
