



THREE CARD POKER

THREE CARD POKER is designed to offer the player an opportunity to enjoy an exciting new table game that is a fun, fast-paced and an easy-to-learn variation of traditional poker.

With two betting methods, the game offers two games in one. A person can bet one method or the other, or both, giving three ways to play. Plus, a unique extra bonus feature allows the player four ways to win.

WAGERS

- Bet the ANTE to play against the dealer.
- Bet the PAIR PLUS to play the hand value only.
- Bet the ANTE and the PAIR PLUS to play both. ANTE and PAIR PLUS may be different amounts. ANTE and PAIR PLUS must be placed before cards are dealt.

ACTION

Each player and the dealer are dealt 3 cards. Players with an ANTE will either:

- Fold and forfeit the ANTE.
- Place a PLAY bet equal to the ANTE. ANTE and PLAY are bets against the dealer. Dealer plays with a Queen high or better.

ANTE AND PLAY PAYOFFS

	PLAY	ANTE
When the dealer does not have a qualifying hand:	Push	1 to 1
When the dealer has a qualifying hand and the player beats the dealer:	1 to 1	1 to 1
When the dealer has a qualifying hand and the player ties the dealer:	Push	Push

ANTE BONUS, regardless of the dealer's hand, is always paid as follows:

Straight Flush	5 to 1
Three-Of-A-Kind	4 to 1
Straight	1 to 1

PAIR PLUS, regardless of dealer's hand, is always paid as follows:

Mini Royal Flush.....	50 to 1
Straight Flush.....	40 to 1
Three-Of-A-Kind.....	30 to 1
Straight.....	6 to 1
Flush.....	3 to 1
Pair.....	1 to 1
High Card.....	0

RANKING OF THE HANDS

STRAIGHT ranks higher than a FLUSH. THREE OF A KIND ranks higher than a STRAIGHT.

CARDS

Ace is always high except in 3-2-A sequence, which is the lowest STRAIGHT (and STRAIGHT FLUSH). When the player has a winning PAIR PLUS bet and an ANTE bet, a PLAY bet must be placed to stay in the game.

6-CARD BONUS PAY TABLE

If the player's hand qualifies for bonus payouts, the dealer pays him/her according to the posted payable. If the player's hand doesn't qualify for payouts, the dealer removes the cards

HAND	PAYS
Super Royal of Diamonds	\$1,000,000
Super Royal of Hearts, Spades or Clubs	\$100,000
Royal Flush	1,000 to 1
Straight Flush	200 to 1
Four of a Kind	50 to 1
Full House	20 to 1
Flush	15 to 1
Straight	10 to 1
Three of a Kind	5 to 1

To begin each round, players must make their standard wagers and, if they like, the 6 card Bonus wager. The dealer then follows house procedures for dealing the regular game.



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
