

FORTUNE ASIA POKER

THE GAME Asia poker is based on an ancient Chinese game called "13 Cards" and combines the elements of Pai Gow Poker and the American game of Poker. The game is played with a traditional deck of 52 playing cards plus one joker. The joker can be used only as an Ace, or to complete a straight, a flush, a straight flush or a royal flush.

HOW TO PLAY

To begin each round, make a standard wager and if you like the Fortune bonus wager. If you wager at least \$5 on the Fortune bonus, the dealer will place an "Envy" button next to your bet. The dealer then follows house procedures for Asian Poker. While reconciling the standard wagers, the dealer also reconciles Fortune Bonus bets. If your hand qualifies for payouts, the dealer pays you according to the posted payable. If your hand does not qualify, the dealer takes your Fortune wager. The dealer pays any Envy Bonuses at the end of the round. If at least one player has a Four-of-a-Kind or higher, all players with envy buttons win: see payable. If more than one player has at least Four-of-a-Kind, then all players with Envy buttons win multiple payouts.

Note: You cannot win Envy Bonuses for your hand or the dealer's hand.

To determine the starting position, the dealer shall count counter clockwise around the table with the position of the dealer considered #1, and continuing around the table with each betting position counted in order, including the dealer, regardless of whether there is a wager at the position, until the count matches the total of the three (3) dice.

Each player shall be responsible for setting his or her own hand. Players may however ask the dealer for assistance in which case the dealer will set the hand according to the house ways. Players must keep all seven cards in plane view at all times. Players may not touch their cards once they have placed them face down on the appropriate area of the layout. A player may announce that he or she wishes to surrender his or her wagers prior to the dealer exposing any of the three hands of that player. Once the player has announced his intention to surrender the dealer will immediately collect the wager and the seven cards without exposing them.

No commission charged on winning wagers.

OBJECT OF THE GAME

A player will win if any two of the player's three hands are higher in rank than any of the dealers, corresponding three hands. If any one of the player's hands is identical in rank to the dealers this is a tie or (Copy hand). The dealer wins all copy hands. No commission charged on winning wagers.

RANKING OF THE HANDS Each player at the table is dealt seven cards, which the player arranges to make three hands; a one-card hand, a two card hand, and a four card hand. When setting the three hands, the four card high hand must be equal to or higher in rank than the two card medium hand, and the two card medium hand must be equal to or higher in rank from the one card low hand.

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
