## Efficient Facility

- >90% of lighting uses high energy efficiency equipment and technology
- >80% of guestrooms are equipped with low-flow showerheads
- HVAC Technologies: building automation systems & variable speed drives



## Sustainable Practices

- Waste Diversion Program: Property sorts all recyclables from waste stream for diversion away from landfills, including paper, glass, aluminum, plastics, furniture, and electronics
- Sheets are changed upon request and towels left hanging are not replaced to save water
- Caesars Atlantic City helps send hundreds of tons of food scraps to feed Krally Farm's pigs each year
- Masters Organic Farms supplies local, organic produce to Nero's, Palace Court Buffet, Gordon Ramsay, Seven Stars Club and Sunday brunch
- Rooftop herb gardens overlooking the pool deck provide fresh ingredients to Caesars restaurants



## Community Partnerships

**Clean the World foundation** recycles used toiletries and distributes them to communities in need all over the world. All used soaps and shampoos are collected from guestrooms daily to assist their mission.

In addition to other philanthropy areas, the Caesars Foundation supports organizations in Atlantic City area that benefit older individuals, including **Meals on Wheels**, which provides home-delivered meals services to people in need, and **Second Wind Dreams**, which changes the perception of aging through the fulfillment of dreams.
