

CAESARS REWARDS HANDICAPPING CHALLENGE OFFICIAL RULES:

- Contest is sponsored by (1) Indiana Grand Racing & Casino, (2) Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino, (3) Harrah's Philadelphia Casino & Racetrack and (4) Harrah's Louisiana Downs (collectively, "Sponsor"). Void where prohibited.
- The eight (8) "Participating Locations" in this contest are the four Sponsor properties and (5) Harrah's Louisiana Downs OTB, (6) Winner's Circle OTB Clarksville, (7) Winner's Circle Pub, Grille & OTB Indianapolis, and (8) Winner's Circle OTB New Haven.
- This is a contest of skill. Contestants must be at least 21 years of age to enter and participate. Free Caesars Rewards membership is required. Contestants can join at any Caesars Rewards Center at a Sponsor property.
- Contest occurs on June 22, 2019 and is limited to the first 400 registrants. Pre-registration is required via phone (866-357-1731) or on-site at Participating Locations. Registration begins May 17, 2019. Cost to enter is \$150. All submitted registrations will be time-stamped. Registration on June 22, 2019 will be allowed if spots remain. Registration will close before the start of the first contest race. Payments can be made with cash or by credit card on June 22, 2019. Once an entry fee is paid, no refunds are available. Registrations are non-transferable.
- Maximum of two (2) paid entries per person. Contestants are prohibited from using multiple names, Caesars Rewards accounts, or any other means to enter more than allowed in these Official Rules. Any attempt to do so is grounds for disqualification and legal action.
- Contestants must place all contest wagers personally. No person shall directly or indirectly act as an intermediary, transmitter or agent in placing wagers for the contestant, provided that Sponsor will make reasonable accommodations for disabled contestants with special needs.
- Must be present at a Participating Location to make contest wagers and to receive any prizes.
- The following persons are ineligible to participate:
 - Officers, directors and employees of Sponsor, any other Participating Location, and any of their respective affiliates ("Prohibited Employees"); and
 - Any member of a Prohibited Employee's immediate family (spouse, child or anyone sharing same primary residence).
- Contestants will receive a food option, light beverages, contest seating and programs.
- Check-in for registered contestants begins at 1:00PM EDT (12:00PM CDT) on Saturday, June 22, 2019 at each Participating Location. All contestants begin with an imaginary bankroll of \$48. Bankrolls are mythical and may not be cashed in at the end of play.
- For each paid entry, contestants must place a mythical \$2 Win and \$2 Place contest wager on ONE horse only per race in 12 mandatory races out of 20 available for this contest on June 22, 2019, at Harrah's Louisiana Downs, Harrah's Philadelphia Casino & Racetrack, Indiana Grand Racing & Casino, and Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino. The 20 available races will be determined by Sponsor. Contestants must place a contest wager on at least one race from each of the four tracks. The contest wagers must be placed at a designated contest location or kiosk.
- A contestant may select any combination of races from tracks from each of the four racetracks, provided contestant selects at least one from each racetrack. If a contestant does not select horses in at least 12 mandatory races from the 20 available, then \$0 will be credited to his or her mythical bankroll for any missing races, and contestant's bankroll will not retain the \$4 for any missing contest wager.
- In the event of a race cancellation for any reason, and if time permits, contestants who wagered on the canceled race will be required to place a contest wager on a different race. Sponsor may, in its discretion, replace any cancelled race with another race scheduled on or after June 22, 2019.
- If a contestant's horse wins, the contestant will be credited on both the Win and Place wagers. If the horse finishes in a place position, the contestant will be credited only on the Place wager. All wagers and payouts from races are mythical and will be used as a score only. **There is a Win payoff cap of 20-1 (\$42.00) and a Place payoff cap of 10-1 (\$22).**
- Entries and fields, if any, are considered a single wagering interest.
- Standings may be displayed periodically from a contest hub. However, standings posted **are not guaranteed** and are unofficial until Sponsor management declares the winners.
- All contestants are responsible for ensuring each wager is placed correctly and has been accepted. Contestants should keep all receipts for verification. It is the contestant's responsibility to be aware of any changes in the designated races.
- If there is a scratch in a designated race, it is the contestant's responsibility to change or cancel their selection prior to post time. In the event of a late scratch that cannot be changed in time, the contestant will receive the post time favorite. Any race contested at a Standardbred track will implement the fair start pole. In the event a horse is declared a non-starter, then the contestant will receive the post time favorite.
- All races are subject to change in Sponsor's discretion. It is the contestant's responsibility to place wagers in a timely and accurate fashion. Sponsor is not responsible for any shut-outs during contest.
- Affidavits will be required of all winners. Winners are solely responsible for all taxes, expenses, costs or fees associated with acceptance and/or use of the prize that are not specifically stated herein as being awarded. Sponsor shall have the right, but not the obligation, to make any deductions and withholdings that Sponsor deems necessary or desirable under applicable federal, state, local or other tax laws, rules, regulations, codes or ordinances.
- At the conclusion of the contest, all play will be audited to verify correct winners. Upon verification, official results will be posted. The contestants with the top ten (10) bankrolls will receive a prize as follows:
 - 1st - \$20,000; a seat at the 2020 National Horseplayers Championship tournament held February 7-9, 2020 at Bally's Las Vegas ("NHC"); roundtrip coach air transportation for winner on a carrier of Sponsor's choice between the major airport closest to winner's residence and Las Vegas, Nevada; hotel accommodations in Las Vegas (consisting of one (1) double-occupancy, standard room) for four days and three nights; and a potential \$1,000,000 bonus prize if winner also wins the NHC tournament (see paragraphs 24 and 25 below for more details);
 - 2nd - \$10,000;
 - 3rd - \$1,500;
 - 4th through 10th - \$500.
- Prize payments may be made in cash or by check in Sponsor's discretion. A contestant with two paid entries is eligible to win two different prizes. Prizes are non-transferable, and no substitution will be made except at Sponsor's sole discretion.
- In the event of a tie, the higher placing will be awarded to the contestant with the greater number of first place horses in the contest races. If the tie still has not been broken, the higher placing will be awarded to the contestant with the highest paying Win selection. If the tie still has not been broken, the higher placing will be awarded to the contestant with the greater number of second place horses in the contest races. If a tie still has not been broken, Sponsor may in its discretion select one or more additional tiebreaking races for which the tied contestants will place a \$2 contest wager on one horse to Win and Place. The higher placing will be awarded to the contestant with the highest mythical bankroll following the tiebreaking race(s).
- The 1st Place winner of this contest will receive a seat in the 2020 NHC tournament organized by the National Thoroughbred Racing Association ("NTRA"). Winner must register with the NHC Tour to participate in the NHC tournament. Sponsor will pay for winner's registration fee if winner is not currently registered for the NHC Tour. The NHC tournament will be subject to additional rules, terms and conditions of the NTRA. If winner is unable or ineligible to participate in the 2020 NHC tournament for any reason, a substitute prize will not be awarded. NHC tournament seat is non-transferable. All decisions of the NTRA regarding the NHC tournament are final.
- If the 1st Place winner of this contest also wins the 2020 NHC tournament, Sponsor or the NTRA will award winner a bonus \$1,000,000 prize. The

bonus prize will be awarded over a 40-year annuity term that pays out \$25,000 per year for forty (40) years without interest. Winner may elect to receive a discounted, lump-sum cash payment of \$550,000.00 in lieu of the annuity payments. Winner may be required to complete additional paperwork and provide additional information to Sponsor or to a third party in order to be eligible to receive the bonus prize.

26. All official track rulings will apply to the horses wagered on in the contest. Licensed horse owners, trainers and jockey agents may participate in the contest, but are required to identify themselves to Sponsor officials prior to the first race of the contest and identify any potential interest they have in any race(s) eligible for wagering in this contest. These participants are ineligible to wager, for contest purposes, on any race in which they have a horse(s) competing, and/or any other interest. Failure to notify a Sponsor official prior to the first race of any interest in any race(s) eligible for wagering in this contest, or wagering on any race where a participant has an interest, will automatically disqualify the contestant from the contest.
27. Sponsor may disqualify any person for fraud, dishonesty, violation of these Official Rules or other misconduct whether or not related to this contest. Sponsor retains the right to disqualify any entry that doesn't comply with the Official Rules or engaging in any conduct deemed inappropriate, disruptive, or unsportsmanlike as determined at the Sponsor's sole discretion.
28. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, mutilated, or illegible entries; electronic transmission errors or delays resulting in omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operations or transmission, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to or alterations of entry materials; technical, hardware, software, or telephone failures or malfunctions of any kind, lost or unavailable connections; fraud; incomplete, garbled, or delayed computer transmissions, whether caused by Sponsor, users, or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the contest or by any technical or human error which may occur in the processing of submissions which may limit, restrict, or prevent a person's ability to participate in the contest.
29. Except as prohibited by law, Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the contest at any time, subject to any required regulatory approval, if Sponsor determines, in its sole discretion, that the contest is not capable of running as planned, including, without limitation, as a result of multiple race cancellations, infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes within or beyond the control of Sponsor which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of this contest.
30. Any individual who is found to be deliberately tampering with the contest entry process or the operation of the contest, to be acting in violation of these Official Rules, or to be acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with the intent to disrupt or undermine the legitimate operation of the contest, or to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person, may be disqualified, and Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages and any other remedies from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law.
31. By entering the contest, contestant agrees on behalf of contestant and contestant's heirs, executors, and administrators (a) to release and hold harmless Sponsor, Sponsor's parent and each of Sponsor's affiliated and subsidiary companies and each of their respective officers, directors, shareholders, members, employees and agents (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any liability, illness, injury, death, loss, litigation, or damage that may occur, directly or indirectly, whether caused by negligence or not, from contestant's participation in the contest and/or contestant's acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of a prize or any portion thereof (including any travel related thereto); (b) to indemnify the Released Parties from any and all liability resulting or arising from contestant's failure to comply with these Official Rules or a breach of any of contestant's representations and warranties; (c) to hereby acknowledge that the Released Parties have neither made nor are in any manner responsible or liable for any warranty, representation, or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or in law, relative to any prize, including express warranties provided exclusively by a prize supplier that are sent along with such prize; (d) if selected as a winner, to the posting of contestant's name on Sponsor's websites and the use by the Released Parties of contestant's name, voice, image, and/or likeness for publicity, promotional, and advertising purposes in any and all media now or hereafter known, throughout the world in perpetuity, without additional compensation, notification, permission, or approval, and, upon request, to the giving of consent, in writing, to such use; and (e) to be bound by these Official Rules and to waive any right to claim any ambiguity or error therein or in the contest itself, and to be bound by all decisions of the judges, which are binding and final.
32. As a condition of entering this contest, contestant agrees that: (1) contestant waives all rights to claim punitive, incidental and consequential damages, and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses incurred in entering the contest, and waive any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased; (2) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with this contest, or any prizes awarded, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action; and (3) any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering this contest, but in no event attorneys' fees.
33. These Official Rules and any disputes relating hereto are governed by the internal laws of (a) the State of Louisiana for contestants participating at Harrah's Louisiana Downs and Harrah's Louisiana Downs OTB; (b) the State of Pennsylvania for contestants participating at Harrah's Philadelphia Casino & Racetrack; or (c) the State of Indiana for contestants participating at Indiana Grand Racing & Casino, Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino, Winner's Circle OTB Clarksville, Winner's Circle Pub, Grille & OTB Indianapolis, and Winner's Circle OTB New Haven. The foregoing laws will apply without regard to principles of conflicts of laws, and by entering, contestant consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the state and federal courts in the applicable state for resolution of any disputes relating to the contest and waive any objection thereto.
