## PHamous Poker Series II Official Rules

1. Planet Hollywood reserves the right to modify or cancel these tournaments at its sole and absolute discretion without prior notice.
2. Registration starts at 10am for scheduled tournaments that day.
3. A Total Rewards Card is required to enter all Phamous Poker Series Tournaments.
4. Once registration is closed all tournament fees will be calculated.
5. W-2G's will be issued for all prizes $\$ 5,000$ and over. No withholding will be taken, only W-2G's issued.
6. Foreign players from treaty countries must provide a valid ITIN or will face $30 \%$ withholding. Refusal to present an ITIN will result in $\mathbf{3 0 \%}$ withholding.
7. Of the $\$ 55$ buy in, $\$ 42$ goes to the prize pool, $\$ 8$ is withheld by Planet Hollywood as a maintenance fee, and $\$ 5$ is withheld for staff toke. Of the $\$ 70$ buy in, $\$ 51$ goes to the prize pool, $\$ 13$ is withheld by Planet Hollywood as a maintenance fee, and $\$ 6$ is withheld for staff toke.
Of the $\$ 85$ buy in, $\$ 63$ goes to the prize pool, $\$ 15$ is withheld by Planet Hollywood as a maintenance fee, and $\$ 7$ is withheld for staff toke.
Of the $\mathbf{\$ 1 1 0}$ buy in, $\$ 82$ goes to the prize pool, $\$ 20$ is withheld by Planet Hollywood as a maintenance fee, and $\$ 8$ is withheld for staff toke.
Of the $\mathbf{\$ 1 6 0}$ buy in, $\$ 126$ goes to the prize pool, $\$ 25$ is withheld by Planet Hollywood as a maintenance fee, and $\$ 9$ is withheld for staff toke.
Bounty Hunter; of the $\$ 70$ buy in $\$ 26$ goes to the prize pool, $\$ 25$ goes to the bounty pool, $\$ 13$ is withheld by Planet Hollywood as a maintenance fee, and $\$ 6$ is withheld for staff toke.
8. Planet Hollywood Poker will make up the difference when a guarantee is not met for a tournament prize pool and Phamous Player Points withholding.
9. Late registration is offered for all events with the exception of events 2 and 14 . Registration for events 2 and 14 end at 4:00pm or when the event reaches 32 players. Late registration is offered until the start of level 9 for all events except for events 2 and 14. Survivor tournament offers late registration until the start of level 7. 10am tournament offers late registration until the start of level 4.
10. In the event a prize pool is chopped the tournament will end when the chop is agreed upon.

## Phamous Player of the Series Rules

1. The Phamous Poker Series will use a cumulative player point system to track participants' success for events $1,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10$, 11, 12, 13, and 15.
2. Player with the most points will be awarded $\$ 1,000$ and the runner up will be awarded $\$ 300$.
3. $\$ 100$ will be withheld from events $1,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13$, and 15 to fund the Phamous Player of the Series awards.
4. In the event of a tie the players will split the award(s) in which they have qualified for.
5. Points will be awarded to the final 9 players in each qualifying event.
6. Points will be calculated and awarded in the following manner;
\$70 buy in events, 1 point per entry
$\$ 85$ buy in events, 1.2 points per entry
$\$ 110$ buy in events, 1.4 points per entry
$\$ 160$ buy in event, 1.8 points per entry
