

# FOUR CARD POKER

---

Four Card Poker features heads - up play against the dealer and two optional bonus bets.

## RANKING OF THE HANDS

Four-of-a-Kind, Straight Flush, Three-of-a-Kind, Flush, Straight, Two Pair, Pair and High Card

## GETTING STARTED

Place the ante to bet to play against the dealer. Make the Aces Up and 6 Card Bonus bets to play against the bonus paytables. You will then receive five cards to make your best Four-Card poker hand. Four-Card Straights are Straights, Four-Card Flushes are Flushes, etc. The dealer receives six cards and turns one card face-up.

## DECISION TIME

After looking at your hand, you have a choice: fold or bet 1X to 3X your ante.

## WINNING AND LOSING

The dealer then reveals his cards and announces his Four-Card Poker Hand. If your hand beats or ties the dealer's your ante and play bets win even money. If your hand loses to the dealer's, your ante and play bets lose.

## AUTOMATIC BONUSES

The top three hands in the game receive automatic bonuses, paid on the ante. You receive these bonuses even if you lose to the dealer.



## ACES UP

The Aces Up side bet pays if your hand is a pair of aces or better. The Aces Up bonus always pays, even if the dealer has a better hand. The higher your hand, the more you win.

## 6 CARD BONUS

The 6 Card Bonus side bet combines your five cards with the one 6 card Bonus card to make the best five-card poker hand. In addition, the casino offers two top payouts that are based on all six cards. To play the 6 Card Bonus side bet you must also make an ante and Aces Up wager.
