

TOP FIVE POKER

Top 5 Poker is an exciting game where each Player and the Dealer are dealt 7 cards to get as many Top 5 highest ranking cards of a deck (A/K/Q/J/10) as possible. The 2-9 cards are ignored. Players win by having more Top 5 (A-10) cards than the Dealer. Standard card rankings (A>K>Q>J>10) are used to break ties between hands with the same number of Top 5 cards.

HOW TO PLAY:

1. Players wager an Ante and any optional bonus bet(s).
2. All players and the Dealer receive 7 cards, dealt face down.
3. A hand is ranked by the total number of Top 5 (A-10) cards.
4. After seeing their cards, Players must wager a Play bet equal to 1x their Ante or fold.
5. After all Players have acted on their hands, the Dealer will reveal his 7 card hand.
6. The Dealer qualifies with a Queen-Jack or better. If the Dealer does not qualify, all remaining Antes push.
7. Winning Player hands are paid even money on the Ante and Play bets on qualifying hands.
8. If the Player and Dealer hands tie, the Play and Ante bets both push.



The top 5 Bonus pays odds on the total amount of A-10 cards in the Player's hand.



The Poker Bonus pays odds on the poker ranking of the Top 5 cards in the Player's hand only.

SAMPLE HAND RANKINGS

The dealer does not qualify with a hand of:



While it contains two Top 5 cards (J/10), it is lower than the two card Queen/Jack qualifier. The 5-card straight flush poker hand is ignored.

The dealer qualifies with a hand of:



Two total Top 5 Cards (A/10) being higher than the Q/J qualifier.

The dealer does not qualify with a hand of:



Two Top 5 cards (J/J) but below the Q/J qualifying hand, pairs do not matter.

The player's two Top 5 cards (K/J) beats the dealer's lower two Top 5 cards (Q/Q) (pairs are irrelevant in the main game hand comparisons).
