

HIGH HANDS

MARCH 6 - 29

WHEN:

- Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays during the qualifying period.

HOW TO QUALIFY:

- Play at a Texas Hold'em Jackpot eligible cash game or Texas Hold'em Jackpot eligible tournament during the qualifying hours.
- Qualification for the High Hands will begin at 2pm and the first payout will be at 2:20pm. Payouts will be every 20 minutes afterwards. Final payout will be at 12am.
- Must win with Aces full of Deuces or better to qualify.
- Minimum of 4 players dealt in at the start of the hand.
- Must use both hole cards.
- Must be \$10 or more in the pot for cash games.
- Must beat the current high hand. Ties will not qualify.
- Must have a Total Rewards card and Valid I.D. to win.

PAYOUTS:

- The first payout each day will be worth \$500, followed by a \$300 payout for the second, and a \$200 payout for the third. This same pattern will repeat for the remainder of each day.
- If any prize, or remainder of a prize, is unclaimed that amount will be added to the following payout.
- In the event that the final payout each day is unclaimed, the remaining prize will be awarded to the next player who qualifies with four Eights or better.

ADDITIONAL RULES:

- Players who win while in a tournament will only be eligible for 50% of the High Hand cash value.
- The time that the final action is completed in a hand will be used to determine the Qualifying Period for which the hand shall qualify. If necessary, a supervisor will use Surveillance to get an official time.
- Management reserves the right to cancel or alter this promotion at any time.
- This promotion may be postponed, rescheduled, or cancelled for the day and/or the value reduced in the event of major weather storms, such as snow or other major events.
- Winners must show a valid I.D. and Total Rewards card to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Winners are responsible for any United States federal, state or local taxes and/or government fees that may be imposed in connection with the acceptance of the prize.
- Players must be 21 or older to participate.
- Any circumstances not covered in the rules will be decided on by a Supervisor or above and will be final.
